

Witnesses in the trial of Mass-Murderer Robert Stewart spent most of Thursday presenting physical evidence produced after the shootings two years ago in the Pinelake Health And Rehabilitation Center. Most of the of the blood evidence, according to agents of the State bureau Of Investigation, came from clothing worn by Stewart during commission of his crimes. The 47-year-old Part-time house painter has confessed killing eight people during a half-hour bloodbath. Stewart claims he doesn't remember a thing but witnesses say he had the presence of mind to conceal a second handgun which hospital medics found while he was being treated for a gunshot wound.
